#### What's been happening

#### Groundworks - On-line Presence - Coffee Morning - Defib/bleed kit training

The hall closed at the beginning of August to allow some ground works to be competed safely and with minimal disruption to the user groups. The photo shows the front of the hall looking neat and tidy: local firm NJ Boulton's have done a great job creating a wide path around the hall with a border to the front ready for planting.

The appeal for 'bulb donations' in the form of the timely free voucher from Byrkley Park Garden centre, was highly successful and in the Spring we should see flashes of yellow in front of the hall! Thank you to everyone who donated their voucher or bulbs.

Steps with a handrail have also been constructed enabling easier access to the car park which is the meeting point in emergency situations. Meachen



and Bevan electricians have installed PIR emergency lighting around the hall, and you may have noticed that the white concrete bollard on the front path has been replaced with two illuminated bollards, one on each side of the path. There is also an illuminated bollard positioned at the top of the steps to the car park. Unfortunately, as we do not own the car park, we are unable to extend lighting or pathway onto this area.

All this work has been possible with the Grant Ward Enhancement Program funding from the East Staffordshire Borough Council, which not only required an application form but also a formal presentation by a team from the Village Hall Committee at Burton.

In August Mary Dorrington ran a short course on Defibrillator and Bleed kit training to support the resources that are mounted on the Village Hall for the community's benefit if ever needed.
