What's been happening - It has been a busy time at your local Village Hall!



Thursday Coffee Mornings are now well-established with typically 20 to 30 residents attending weekly. Initially, our funding came from ESBC and covered the winter months. With all the positive feedback, Trent and Dove have awarded a grant enabling us to carry on. 'Themed' mornings have been organised including: visits from Coffee Connect; a talk from James

Wakefield, from Residential Energy Services, advising on energy efficiency in the home (a return visit was needed due to the demand!); and The Globe Foundation from Uttoxeter talking about recycling and their Repair Room. Red Nose Day was also supported and the sale of cakes raised £60. Newcomers are always welcome for FREE tea and coffee: there is always someone to chat to so don't worry that you won't know anyone. We do have children's toys and games so little ones are also welcome. The ESBC grant also provided for a projector and screen which has been installed in the Main Hall enabling visitors' better quality for their presentations.

We are happy to say that our new cleaner is a local resident and he is doing a great job!

Whilst we have felt it necessary to increase Hall hire charges slightly from April to keep inline with inflation and cover our regular outgoings: we know that our rates are still very competitive and this is reflected in the increased number of bookings.



A new addition to our weekly programme is the Arts and Crafts Social Group which runs on Tuesdays at 1pm till 3pm and is proving to be very popular.
