What's been happening - Another busy few months at your local Village Hall!

What a busy Spring there has been at your Village Hall with a flurry of Children's Parties, a christening, and a delightful Wedding at the Church and afterwards at the hall which had been beautifully decorated. We have had two elections (in case you missed them) and are delighted to welcome back the Uttoxeter Rural Parish Council who now hold alternate meetings at the Stramshall Village Hall to be closer to the community – please come along to contribute your thoughts to their good work around the Parish.



The AGM was held on 6th June. Attendance slightly up on last year which was encouraging! Residents were invited for light refreshments before the meeting which allowed the opportunity to look around a display of all the regular activities that are on at the hall as well as some great 'before and after' photographs of the improvements and

cosmetic changes that have been made to the hall over the last year. At the meeting the existing committee members all declared that they were happy to continue their service for the next 12 months and a growing number of new volunteers wishing to help behind the

scenes. Committee roles were assigned at the committee meeting which immediately followed the AGM: one significant change is the role of Treasurer which has been carried out by Joy Oulsnam for many years. Joy now feels that the time is right to take a step back from the position and we thank her whole-heartedly for the many years of service she has given.





<u>Stramshall Out and About Weekend</u> in June was a real community event. Encompassing, the Church Fair, held on Saturday afternoon and this was followed by an Indoor Community Picnic with live music organised by the Village Hall in the evening. On Sunday, Stramshall ACE organised an

excellent Treasure Hunt based from the Village Hall with refreshments and children's games; and Open Gardens were arranged by the Gardening Club including the Tean Valley Meadows and Turn Education.

Special thanks go out to the Tuesday Art and Crafts Social Club for the colourful bunting which was used to decorate the hall - it gives the hall a lovely summery feel. Thanks also to David and Karen Moore for providing the musical entertainment with a cameo appearance from Craig Harrison at the Indoor Picnic.

Early July saw the arrival of the new front door and replacement Fire Door. The money raised from the Indoor Picnic has helped fund the new doors, along with a donation from the Rural Parish Council and existing funds left over from the Covid Grant.

What is in the pipeline?

Summer heralds more improvement work scheduled during our quietest period to reduce impact on the regular users of the Hall.

The Village Hall will be closed from Tuesday 6th August until 16th August whilst scheduled work to put in an emergency pathway around the village hall from the fire escape including steps up to the car park (meeting Point) is carried out. This will also have emergency lighting; all this work has been mainly funded by a grant from East Staffordshire Borough Council for which we are very grateful.

We are working with a Staffordshire University student to improve our website and social media presence. Meanwhile, keep an eye out on 'Stramshall Village Hall', 'Stramshall ACE' and 'Stramshall, Spath and Hollington Community Group' Facebook pages for weekly updates.
